

Ossian Town Board Minutes

- Purpose:** Regular Board Meeting

- Call to Order:** The Regular Board Meeting of the Ossian Town Board was called to order by Supervisor Knapp at 7:30 pm.
- Pledge to Flag** The pledge to the flag was led by Holley Smalt.
- Approval of Minutes:** The minutes for the May 12, 2020 Regular Board Meeting were presented. Councilman Pero moved to accept the May 12, 2020 minutes. Councilman Patane seconded the motion. Carried.
- Communications:** None
- Financial Report:** The Financial Report for May 2020 was distributed by the Supervisor. Total receipts were \$1,986.58 and total disbursements were \$55,957.43. Councilman Pero moved to accept the Financial Report as presented. Councilman Patane seconded the motion. Carried.
- Claims:** Highway claims #73 through #88 totaling \$135,646.82 and General Fund claims #64 through #71 totaling \$1,058.88 were presented for payment. Councilman Pero moved to accept all claims as presented. Councilman Patane seconded the motion. Carried.
- Reports:** Town Clerk Rauber reported a total business for May 2020 of \$107.00. The Towns share is \$107.00 which is presented to the Supervisor. He also reported that he has a “ Release of Bond” from the Livingston County Treasurer for the 2020 Tax Collection. Code Enforcement Officer Bourgoine reported that he issued 3 building permits in the month of May. He responded to a complaint on Christian Rd. or excessive junk on the property but found that it had been cleaned up upon his arrival. Town Historian Rhea Walker sent in her report. She reported that she has sent pictures of two historic markers to the Pomeroy Foundation. The Historical Society newsletter has been sent out. The newsletter contains biography’s of our Towns teens that were honored by the County. Assessor Smalt reported that Grievance Day experienced no one attending to grieve. She is now putting together the Final Roll. Deanne Knapp stated that she has been in touch with the

Armstrong Company. They are now ready to do hookups for internet. They stated that start –ups are off to a slow start.

Other Business: Supervisor Knapp reported that he still has not received a reply from the Town of Nunda on the Shaw Road maintenance issue. The Board discussed the issue of joining the Association of Towns for a cost on \$600.00. Councilman Pero moved to join the Assoc. of Towns at a cost of \$600.00 for one year. Councilman Patane seconded the motion. Carried.

Adjournment: Councilman Pero moved to adjourn. Council Patane seconded the motion. Carried. Meeting was adjourned at 7:56 pm.
