

Pre-Apprenticeship Program for Economically Disadvantaged Youth

The Northeast Carpenters Apprenticeship is seeking economically disadvantaged youths (18-24), to participate in a six week Pre-Apprenticeship Program. Candidates that successfully complete this program will be offered a direct-entry into an apprenticeship with the Northeast Carpenters Apprenticeship Fund. Starting wages for apprentices are currently between \$12.78 in the Rochester area, to 20.32 in the Hauppauge area. This six week Pre-apprentice Training will take place at training centers located in Hauppauge, Rock Tavern, Albany and Rochester NY. Training will start in early May 2017 and end mid-June, in time for the summer construction increase. Interested candidates must:

1. Be between 18-24 years of age
2. Be financially disadvantaged
3. Have a High School diploma/ TASC/GED
4. Have a reliable means of transportation
5. Be a resident of NYS, (excluding NYC)
6. Be registered with the One Stop Job Center

Participants will be furnished with appropriate footwear, a selection of hand tools, and lunches. There is no cost to the Participants.
